Mobile Medical / Health Unit Project (MMU/MHU)

MMU/MHU project focuses on providing a wide range of promotive, preventive and curative healthcare services at doorstep. J. V. Gokal Charity Trust aims to reach out to the underprivileged communities, especially in the rural areas which lack basic healthcare facility. For addressing their healthcare needs, JVGCT has initiated "Mobile Healthcare Project".

Our concept of "Community Based Healthcare Delivery Model", envisages an efficient & cost effective healthcare delivery system for rural and remote geographies. It aspires for reaching self-sustainability through active community participation and replacement of cost through linkages.

Quality services are provided by team of doctor, public health nurse or trained health attendant, a social worker or community mobiliser. Apart from general health checkup, we also organise health camps for school children and speciality camps for eye care and other illnesses.

Many health professionals volunteer at our various mobile clinic sites. We welcome professionals and volunteers to come forward for such initiatives.

















Mobile Medical / Health Unit Project (MMU/MHU) ...

Each MMU/MHU visits three to four villages or hamlets in a day. Patients are provided with doctor's consultation, medications and nutritional supplements at no cost to the patient. Promotion of health seeking behaviour, safe motherhood, vaccination, personal hygiene, balanced diet and awareness about various communicable and non-communicable diseases are done through this health care delivery system.

More than 90,000 people are benefitted from our MMU/MHUs.

These laboratories are manned with a team of qualified Pathologists, Doctors, Laboratory Technicians & Laboratory Attendants. Patients avail benefit of these labs at highly subsidised rate as compared to other pathology laboratories.

"Jagjivan" Low Cost Surgery Centre

J. V. Gokal Charity Trust in association with "Medicare Surgical and Dental Hospital", Nandurbar, Maharashtra have started "Jagjivan Low Cost Surgery Centre", in 2014.

JVGCT is working with the vision to offer affordable surgical treatment to the patients those who come from lower socio-economic strata. Majority of the population residing in this project area (about 70%) belong to tribal community. Many of them remain untreated due to their poor financial condition. Medicines and surgical supplies (pre-operative, operative, post-operative) are provided to them by JVGCT.

About 450 individuals have benefitted by this project during FY 2017 - 18





Arun Jagjivan Gokal Institute of Community Ophthalmology (AJGICO)

Arun Jagjivan Gokal Institute of Community Ophthalmology is located in the premises of S. S. Borda Hospital, Bhubaneswar. Care for various eye illness and control of preventable blindness are main focus areas of the project. Every month, more than Five Hundred Cataract surgeries are conducted at this institute. These surgeries are done free of cost to the patients. A team of dedicated ophthalmic surgeons and support staff relentlessly work towards this cause. The institute also conducts eye screening camps routinely in schools and slums of Bhubaneswar.

AJGICO is on the path of expanding its reach by replicating this model at Paradeep Port. The focal point here is on Dock, Industrial Workers, Truckers and also local communities. Our team participate in various government programs related to blindness control. This project is implemented in association with Sri Sri Parama Premamaya Purusottam Trust, Shushrusha Charitable Trust, Vision Foundation and Sight Savers.

Total Surgeries conducted are 2112 in the FY 2017 - 18.














Primary Eye Care Centres,

Odisha



Every week, a team consisting of Ophthalmologist, Ophthalmic Assistant, Nurse and Support Staff from AJGICO visit these Primary Eye Care Centres. Patients are screened for eye illness and then brought to the hospital at Bhubaneswar for further treatment. After treatment, they are observed for a day and dropped back to their respective places. Transportation, accommodation, food and treatment are provided at no cost to the patient.

Annually more than 18000 patients are screened through these centres.















JVGCT's InTOUCH Health Science Centres

Mao and National Games Village; Imphal, Manipur.

JVGCT has designed these health science centres as affordable, low cost and self-sustaining healthcare delivery model for rural and urban population. Through these centres, we provide a comprehensive range of primary healthcare services to the underserved. The doctor's consultation, diagnostic laboratory services and medicines through pharmacy are given to the patients at subsidised and affordable cost.

Clinic at Mao

Due to hilly terrain, accessing basic healthcare facilities itself is a challenge; hence **JVGCT** launched its first primary health centre at Mao. This project serves community residing in **Twenty Five** villages around Mao.

Clinic at Imphal

In association with Mary Kom Regional Boxing Foundation, JVGCT, have started it's second health science centre in Imphal. This centre caters to more than 1000 families residing in the National Games Village and also to the inmates of Mary Kom Boxing Academy.

Both projects are implemented in association with 'Integrated Tribal Organisation for Upliftment Communication & Health' (InTOUCH).

Maternal and Child Health (MCH) Project

Talasari, Dist. Palghar (Maharashtra)

This project is designed to address key issues related to safe motherhood and malnutrition in remote tribal villages of Talasari block, Palghar district in Maharashtra. JVGCT with support from L&T Public Charitable Trust has initiated this project which aims to improve maternal & child health indicators by involving multiple stakeholders like Accredited Social Health Activist (ASHA), Auxiliary Nurse Mid-Wife (ANM), Anganwadi Workers, School Teachers, Mothers, Adolescence, Community Leaders and Healthcare Professionals (public/private healthcare facilities). Project team focus in bringing out behaviour change of the community by methods like one to one counseling, conducting awareness sessions by use of flip charts, presentations, videos and strengthening healthcare system by Capacity Building of Healthcare Professionals.

Objectives of the project are as follows

- Increase Institutional Deliveries.
- Increase Immunisation Coverage of children under 5 years of age & Ante Natal Cases.
- Improve Nutritional Status of SAM (Severe Acute Malnourished) and MAM (Moderate Acute Malnourished) children.

Involvement in Stop TB Initiative

Mao, Manipur

Stop TB partnership is a roadmap for accelerating impact on TB epidemic and to reach target of the WHO's End TB Strategy. JVGCT has joined hands with The Union (International NGO), Government of India towards fighting TB in the rural & hilly region of Mao, Manipur.

Orientation by The Union

The Union and District Tuberculosis Office (DTO), Senapati, conducted basic orientation program on TB, technical modalities, available Government Schemes & facilities. The objective of this one day orientation was to build capacity (knowledge, skills, and attitude) of the staff deployed at JVGCT's InTouch Health Science Centre, ASHA workers and health facilitators for better implementation of the project in targeted geographies.

Training for Designated Microscopic Centre (DMC)

Technical Experts from District TB Control Office conducted training for JVGCT's InTouch Health Science Centre.

Trainees were briefed about the operations of DMC and various methods used for diagnosis of TB.

Launch of Designated Microscopic Centre

Deputy Commissioner - District Senapati, State TB Officer and DTO launched DMC-cum-DOT (Designated Microscopic Center and Directly Observed Treatment) at JVGCT's InTouch Health Science Centre.

TB Day Observation, Talasari, Maharashtra

24th March is observed as World TB Day. **JVGCT** in association with Dayanand School of Nursing, Talasari conducted rally to create awareness about TB.











Nilam Arun Gokal Academic Library,

Punanamei, Manipur

"Libraries are the foundation for learning!" - Mark Davis

Education for underprivileged being one of the core objective of J. V. Gokal Charity Trust, we have identified Mao as a much needed area for intervention. For getting quality education, students from Mao hills need to travel to far off places like Imphal and Kohima. Lack of proper educational infrastructure in the vicinity have led many families to drop their children's education.

JVGCT has set up Nilam Arun Gokal Academic Library at Asufu Christian Institute campus, Punaname. This library was inaugurated by **Padma Bhushan Smt. MC Mary Kom** in 2015. Since its inception, it has helped many students and teaching staff with ready availability of academic and reference books. This library is managed by a full time librarian and a caretaker.

More than 400 students & teachers are benefitted by this library.













Nilam Arun Gokal Digital Academic Library,

Kariapatti, Tamil Nadu.

The digital library cum smart class room initiative undertaken by J. V. Gokal Charity Trust in association with St. Mary's Matriculation School, is located in the rural area of Kariapatti, Tamil Nadu. The smart class is equipped with latest Hi-Tech Digital Board which helps the children to view 3D images and learn from more realistic visuals and diagrams. This smart class initiative have helped the students improve their academic grades and school attendance.

Every year more than 800 students get the benefit of this project.









Skill Development (Computer) Training Centre,

Punanamei, Manipur

J. V. Gokal Charity Trust with support from Radiant (International) Pvt. Ltd. has set-up a computer training centre at Punanamei village. This centre is equipped with Twenty latest configured computers. Project is aimed to prepare youths for their employment, as it is made mandatory by the government to have computer skills. ACI's students and youths from surrounding villages are benefitted by this computer training centre.

















Ophthalmic Clinical Assistant Training Course

Bhubaneshwar, Odisha

J. V. Gokal Charity Trust has started two year duration Training Course of Clinical Assistant in Community Ophthalmology at Arun Jagjivan Gokal Institute of Community Ophthalmology. This is aimed for creating skilled ophthalmic clinical professionals for our Eye Health Facilities, as well as the community. Every year we train Ten students in community eye care by giving them in depth knowledge. We offer theoretical, practical and hands on experience for every students. After successful completion of the course, these students are absorbed by various eye care institutions and ophthalmologist for their clinics.

This Course is coordinated by Shushrusha Charitable Trust at S. S. Borda Hospital, Bhubaneswar with support from Sri Sri Parama Premamaya Purusottam Trust.













Medical Attendant Certificate Course,

Kohima, Nagaland

Professionally skilled personals are the necessity for quality services and lack of them in health care system is today's major concern worldwide. To reduce this gap, Oking Hospital has started 'Medical Attendant Certificate Course' of two years duration. This course enable students in attaining knowledge of primary healthcare and first aid. About Twenty girls from remote areas of Nagaland are trained annually. After completion of this course, they get employment in government healthcare system as Village Health Nurse, private hospitals and other healthcare facilities. JVGCT supports this course by various means. We also encourage these girls to go back to their respective villages and help community by providing primary healthcare.













ACI' Jagjivan Sports Academy,

Punanamei, Manipur

This is the first Sports Academy in the hilly region of Manipur, imparting professional training in football. JVGCT initiated this project in association with Asufu Christian Institute. Every year more than fifty students are trained at ACI's Jagjivan Sports Academy. The trainees for this academy are selected based on stringent selection process, through which the aspiring youths from near by colleges are admitted. These students are trained for two hours every day in the evening after their regular class. This academy is manned with a team of trained, certified coach and other support staff.

Healthcare

In India, majority population reside in remote villages. Inadequate healthcare infrastructure prevents them to enjoy life at its fullest. Many a times, they do not get access to basic health services. JVGCT conducts periodic community health camp at various locations. Medical checkup, consultation and medicines are given at free of cost to the patients. Iron, Calcium, Folic acid and Multi Vitamins supplements are given to improve their general health. These camps were conducted in association with like - minded organisations from the respective localities.

Balanced nutrition is a key requirement for good health. **JVGCT** in association with L & T Public Charitable Trust conducted **IYCF** Awareness Campaign in Talasari. This was intended to improve health indicators of the tribal area. Our team implemented this activity to educate mothers (of children below two years of age) and the community about the importance of breast feeding & care, which is to be taken for mothers & new born children under-two years of age. Campaign focused in bring out **Behavioral Change** of the community for which various modes of Information, Education & Communication (IEC) materials were used.

Dayanand School of Nursing is the only institute in Palghar Block which provides nursing education to the girls from tribal community. To encourage new students, **JVGCT** supported the "**Lamp Lighting ceremony**". This ceremony was intended to mark the initiation of nursing students towards the profession, where dedication and tireless service is the facemark. Life experience and importance of service were emphasized to the students and their family.

Empowering & Equipping Nurses

JVGCT's trustees have vision to empower and encourage students from lower socio economic strata. Nurses those who have successfully completed **Auxiliary Nurse & Midwifery (ANM)** training were recognised by giving Certificates & Medical Kits in the presence of their parents

Support to Study Tour

Study tour was organised for the students of ACI. Thirty five students from Mao, Manipur along with their faculty visited Pondicherry (Tamil Nadu) and Cochin (Kerala). This trip helped the students gain exposure of culture and heritage of the southern part of India, as this was the first time for them to travel other than northeastern belt of India, JVGCT partly supported this activity.

Annadaan (Food Donation), Support for Differently Abled Children

With support from **Shree Krishna Foundation**, **JVGCT** provide monthly groceries to the residential school which is specially for the differently abled children of Parner, Ahmednagar District, Maharashtra

Rain Water Harvesting,

Tagarkheda, Latur District, Maharashtra

Rainwater conservation is a key element of any strategy that aims to alleviate water scarcity. With rainfall patterns changing every year, water scarcity is a problem faced by the rural community. JVGCT in association with Tagarkheda village community started working on this issue. After looking at various means, it was decided water conservation through rain water harvesting is the best sustainable means to fight water scarcity. Before the monsoon, pits were dug-up near paddy fields and selected open spaces in the village depending upon the topography of the land/area, so that the rain water can be stored. This was done with active community participation.

Kitchen Garden Demonstration & Seed Distribution,

Kitchen garden demonstration was conducted at Jambhulpada village, Raigad district, with technical support from **Rajmata Jijau Mother-Child Health & Nutrition Mission**, Maharashtra. More than seventy five individual (Community elders) from different villages were trained with the help of audio visuals. Seeds, plants and tree saplings were distributed to all participants for replicating similar model in their respective villages.

Warm Cloth Distribution

Sweaters were distributed to hundred Children of ashramshala (tribal boarding school). **JVGCT** in association with **Noble Hygiene** carried out this activity.

Research



J. V. Gokal Charity Trust Project Team is exploring possibilities of collaborative research. These are following projects in preliminary discussion:

- Validation of a new test for detecting Breast Cancer
- Breast Cancer Screening of women from China, India, Russia, Brazil, South Africa and Thailand under the auspices of WHO IARC (World Health Organisation International Agency for Research on Cancer).
- KAP (Knowledge, Attitude and Practices) about Self Breast Examination related studies among rural parts of India.

Research in association with Vellore Institute of Technology (VIT, Vellore)

Reproductive health is a universal concern, yet it is specifically important to women during reproductive years. It is a crucial part of general health of any women. It is essential to take steps to protect reproductive organs from cancer. Reproductive cancers such as breast cancer, cervical, uterus, vulva, endometrial and ovaries cancer are common among women. Among these cancers, breast cancer has received highest priority as the rates of this cancer are more in India. Hence, breast cancer need adequate attention and regular screening for early diagnosis to prevent higher mortality rates. The purpose of this project is to identify the relationships between value drivers of women and their breast screening beliefs. The study also aims to examine a comprehensive model containing the relationships between socio-ecological variables and breast cancer screening beliefs. This study would provide various implications for pubic health policy makers. (Proposal by Dr. C. Padmavathy)
